Our community will include 70 pupils in the first year, rising slowly to 150 pupils over 4 years.

We are privileged to be able to cater for our learners across their whole childhood from 3-19 years of age.

All our pupils will have an Education Health Care Plan (EHCP) which demonstrates significant delay in attainment and complex learning needs (PMLD or SLD).
